NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACT,
1924.

the National Health Insurance Joint Com-
mittee, after the expiration of at least 40 days
from this date, in pursuance of the powers
conferred upon them by Section 39 of, and
paragraph (14) of the Third Schedule to, the
National Health Insurance Act, 1924, and by
the National Health Insurance (Joint Com-
mittee) Regulations, 1924, to make regulations
amending Articles 81 and 96 of, and the
Fifteenth Schedule to, the National Health
Insurance (Approved Societies) Regulations,
1924.

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF
AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 23RD MARCH, 1925.)

FOOT - AND - MOUTH DISEASE (IN-
FECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1925
(No. 19).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries,
by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested
in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts,
1894 to 1922, and of every other power
enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as
follows:—

Contraction of certain Infected Area.

1. The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected
Areas) Order of 1925 (No. 17) shall be read
and have effect as if the Area described in
the Schedule to this Order were substituted
for the Infected Area described in the
Schedule to that Order.
