

(i) For certain regulations as to the use of air at high pressure in connection with the consumption of gas, and for power to make specifications with regard to the size and materials of pipes and the fittings thereof.

(j) For liberty to the Company to pay the costs of the above-mentioned Order out of the revenues of the Company.

And notice is hereby given that any Local or other Public Authority, Company, or person desiring to bring before the Board of Trade any objection to the Draft Order may do so by registered letter addressed to the Director of Gas Administration, Board of Trade, Great George Street, London, S.W. 1, and despatched on or before the 8th day of July, 1925. GRAVESEND ELECTRICITY (EXTENSION).

(Extension of Area of Supply of the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Gravesend under the Gravesend Electric Lighting Order 1898 and the Gravesend (Extension to Northfleet) Electric Lighting Order 1905 so as to include the parishes of Darenth, Fawkham, Hartley, Horton Kirby, Longfield, Southfleet, Stone and Swanscombe in the Rural District of Dartford and the parishes of Chalk, Denton, Ifield, Meopham and Nurstead and part of the parish of Cobham in the Rural District of Strood, in the County of Kent: Provisions as to prices: Power to break up Streets in added areas: Use of Electricity supplied for purposes of Railways, Tramways and Canals: Incorporation of Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act 1899: Amendment or Repeal of said Orders: Repeal

revocation or amendment of powers of Kent Electric Power Company and West Kent Electric Company Limited to supply electricity within any part of added areas or existing area of supply: Miscellaneous and Incidental provisions).

NOTICE is hereby given that the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Gravesend (hereinafter called "the Corporation") whose address is The Town Hall, Gravesend, are applying to the Electricity Commissioners for a Special Order (hereinafter called "the Order") under the Electricity (Supply) Acts 1882 to 1922 for all or some of the following purposes (that is to say):—

To extend the area for the supply of electrical energy by the Corporation so as to enable them to provide and distribute electrical energy for all public and private purposes as defined by the said Acts within the parishes of Darenth, Fawkham, Hartley, Horton Kirby, Longfield, Southfleet, Stone and Swanscombe in the Rural District of Dartford and the parishes of Chalk, Denton, Ifield, Meopham and Nurstead and so much of the parish of Cobham as is situate west of a line drawn from Shepherds Gate in Watling Street southwards along the east side of Halfpence Lane and the continuation thereof touching the west side of Cobhambury Wood to the southern boundary of the parish near Henley Croft in the Rural District of Strood in the County of Kent (hereinafter referred to as "the added areas") and to regulate the prices to be charged for such supplies in the added areas and in the Borough of Gravesend and the Urban District of Northfleet.

To extend and make applicable to the added areas all or some of the powers and provisions contained in the Gravesend Electric Lighting Order 1898, and the Gravesend (Extension to Northfleet) Electric Lighting Order 1905.
