

In the Rural District of Strood :—

In the Parish of Chalk :—

Main London to Dover Road.  
Old Road East.

In the Parish of Cobham :—

New Watling Street.

Road leading from New Watling Street through Henhurst to Jeskins Court and through Cobham Village to the entrance to the Avenue leading to Cobham Hall.

Road leading from Owletts through Sole Street to Southern boundary of Parish.

Roadway and approaches to the bridge carrying the road from Owletts through Sole Street over the Southern Railway (South Eastern and Chatham Section) at Sole Street Station.

In the Parish of Denton :—

Main London to Dover Road.  
Old Road East.  
Range Road.

In the Parish of Ifield :—

New Watling Street.

In the Parish of Meopham :—

Main Road from Gravesend to Wrotham.

Roadway on and approaches to the Bridge carrying the Main Road from Gravesend to Wrotham over the Southern Railway (South Eastern and Chatham Section) to Meopham Station.

Road leading from Sole Street to the junction with the Main Road from Gravesend to Wrotham.

In the Parish of Nurstead :—

Main Road from Gravesend to Wrotham.

(b) Railway :—

In the Parish of Denton :—

Level crossing over the Southern Railway (South Eastern and Chatham Section) (North Kent Branch) near Denton Halt.

(c) Tramways :—

The tramways of the Gravesend and Northfleet Electric Tramways Limited so far as they are situate in the added areas of supply.

The streets and parts of streets in which it is proposed that electric lines shall be laid down within a specified time are as follows :—

In the Rural District of Dartford :—

In the Parish of Stone :—

London Road from Horns Cross to Eastern boundary of Parish.

In the Parish of Swanscombe :—

London Road.

In the Rural District of Strood :—

In the Parish of Meopham :—

Wrotham Road from Northern boundary of Parish to Meopham Green.

In the Parish of Nurstead :—

Wrotham Road.

To incorporate with or without amendment all or some of the provisions of the Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act 1899 and to repeal alter or amend so much of the Gravesend Electric Lighting Order 1898 as extended by the Gravesend (Extension to Northfleet) Order 1905 as may be necessary and to revoke cancel amend or repeal so much of the Kent Electric Power Act 1902, the Kent Electric Power Act 1906 and the West Kent Electric Power Act 1909 or any other Act or Order now in force within any part of the added areas or existing area of supply as may be necessary to give effect to the purposes of the Order.

To authorise the Corporation in the event of their obtaining the consent of the Minister of Transport under Sub-section (1) of Section 5 of the Electric Lighting Act 1909 to the supply by them within their area of supply (including the added areas) of electricity for the purposes of haulage or traction on any railway, tramway or canal situate partly within and partly without that area or for the purposes of lighting vehicles and vessels used on any such railway tramway or canal, to supply electricity to be used for purposes incidental to the working or lighting of such railways, tramways and canals other than the purposes aforesaid.

To confer upon the Corporation all or some of the powers contained in the Electricity (Supply) Acts 1882 to 1922 and the enactments incorporated therewith and to alter vary or extinguish all rights and privileges which will or may interfere with any of the objects of the Order and to confer other rights and privileges.

And notice is hereby given that the draft of the Order has been deposited at the offices of the Electricity Commissioners and printed copies of the draft Order as applied for and of the Order when made may be obtained (at the price of two shillings for each copy) at the offices of the undermentioned Town Clerk and Parliamentary Agents and of Mr. Leonard Randerson, Surveyor, Blendonville, Meopham, near Gravesend, and Mr. W. T. Symons, Swanscombe Parish Council Offices, Church Road, Swanscombe, Kent.

And notice is hereby further given that every local or other public authority company or person desirous of bringing any objection respecting the application must do so by registered letter addressed to the Secretary, Electricity Commission, Gwydyr House, Whitehall, S.W. 1, and despatched on or before the 29th day of June, 1925, and a copy of such objection must at the same time be forwarded to the undersigned Town Clerk or Parliamentary Agents.
