RUSHDEN AND DISTRICT ELECTRICITY (EXTENSION) SPECIAL ORDER, 1925.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Electricity Commissioners have submitted to the Minister of Transport for confirmation under the above-mentioned Acts a Special Order made by them for the supply by the Rushden and District Electric Supply Company Limited of electricity within the Urban District of Oundle and parts of the Rural Districts of Thrapston and Oundle, all in the County of Northampton.

The Minister of Transport proposes to confirm the Order and gives notice that any person affected who may be desirous of objecting to the confirmation of the same must in accordance with the Electricity (Confirmation of Special Orders) Rules, 1921, do so by memorial addressed to the Minister of Transport written on one side only of foolscap paper and sent by registered post addressed to the Secretary, Ministry of Transport, 6, Whitehall Gardens,

London, S.W. 1, and posted not later than the 27th day of June, 1925. A copy of any such memorial must also be sent in like manner to Messrs. Browne and Wells, 2, St. Giles' Square, Northampton, or to Messrs. Deacon and Company, 9, Great St. Helens, London, E.C. 3, Solicitors for the Order. Such memorial must be sealed or signed by the person objecting or by some responsible and duly authorised person on his behalf and must state the specific grounds of objection to the Order and the modifications desired.

Copies of the Order as submitted for confirmation may be obtained at a price not exceeding two shillings each at the office of Mr. W. G. Brown, Clerk to the Thrapston Parish Council, Market Place, Thrapston, and at the offices of the before-mentioned Solicitors.
