LLANTARNAM ELECTRICITY.

(Supply of Electricity in the Urban District of Llantarnam, Laying of electric lines; Breaking up streets, etc., Maximum Price, etc.).

A PPLICATION has been made by the Llantarnam Urban District Council whose address is Victoria Street, Cwmbran, Llantarnam (hereinafter referred to as "the Undertakers") to the Electricity Commissioners under the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1922, for a Special Order for the following objects:—

1. To authorise the Undertakers to supply and distribute electricity for all public and private purposes as defined by the Electricity (Supply) Acts within the urban district of Llantarnam in the county of Monmouth (hereinafter referred to as "the area of supply").

2. To authorise the Undertakers to exercise within the area of supply all powers usually conferred on distributors of electricity.

3. To prescribe and limit the price to be charged for electricity.

4. The streets and parts of streets in which it is proposed that electric lines shall be laid down within a specified time are:—

Commercial Street.

Victoria Road.

Llantarnam Road from Victoria Road to road leading to Lodge Farm from a point south of Dowlais Bridge.

Lan-Dowlais Street from a point one hundred yards west of Ebenezer Chapel to Oakfield Road.

Oakfield Road.

Grange Road.

Coronation Road.

Wesley Street from Commercial Street for a distance of one furlong.

Clomendy Road from Commercial Street to the Llantarnam Urban District Boundary.

Hill Top from Commercial Street for a distance of two hundred and forty yards.

Oak Street from Commercial Street for a distance of one hundred and seventy yards.

Pen-y-Waun Road from Hill Top to Pen-y-Waun Cottage.

Yew Tree Terrace from Pen-y-Waun Road for a distance of one hundred yards.

Woodside Road.

Woodside Terrace.

Green Hill Road.

Spring Street.

Forgehammer Row.

Thomas Street from Grange Road for a distance of ninety yards.

Somerset Street from Grange Road for a distance of eighty-five yards.

Woodland Street from Clomendy Road for a distance of three hundred and forty yards.

Abbey Road.

Hill Street.

Belle Vue Road.

Star Street.

5. The streets and parts of streets not repairable by a local authority and the railways which the Undertakers propose to take powers to break up are:—

(a) County Roads—

The main road from Newport to Pontypool so far as situate in the area of supply.

The main road leading from the last-mentioned road at Llanvihangel-Llantarnam to Pontynewydd and called in parts Llantarnam Road Victoria Road Coronation Road and Woodside Road.

(b) Other Roads—

The road from parish road near Ty Gwyn to Pentrebach.

The road leading in an easterly direction from a point in Newport-Llantarnam Road about two hundred and fifty yards south of the cross roads at Croes-y-Mwyalch Farm.

The road from Llantarnam leading to Lodge Farm.

The road from Brook House leading to and beyond Llantarnam Abbey.

The road from Magna Porta leading to Llantarnam Abbey.

The road from the Lodge by Llantarnam Station past the Saw Mill to Llantarnam Abbey and thence to Ty-lsaf and thereafter to the southern boundary of Llantarnam Urban District.

The road from the Newport-Pontypool Road to Llantarnam Station.

The road from the last-mentioned road to Llantarnam Road.

The road from Llantarnam Road to Plas Newydd.

The road from parish road leading to Ty-Coch Farm.

The road from parish road leading to Grove Farm.

The road from parish road leading to Pant-Glas Cottages and thence to Pant Glas and thence to Rachel's Lock.

The road from near Top Lock past Pentre Basket leading to Pentre Basket Cottages and thence in a easterly direction to the weir near Rachel's Lock.

The road from parish road leading to Cefn Perthy.

The road from parish road leading to New House.
