## CLACTON ELECTRICITY (EXTENSION).

THE Urban District Council of Clacton (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") whose address is at the Council Offices, Clacton-on-Sea, in the county of Essex, have applied to the Electricity Commissioners under the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1922, for a Special Order for the following objects:—

- (a) To authorise the Council to generate, transform and distribute electrical energy for all public and private purposes as defined by the above Acts within the parish of Little Holland in the Rural District of Tendring (hereinafter referred to as "the area of supply");
- (b) To extend the powers of the Council under the Clacton Electric Lighting Order, 1900, to the area of supply;
- (c) To make provision as to the maximum prices to be charged for supplies in the area of supply;

- (d) To authorise the Council to exercise within the area of supply the powers usually conferred on distributors of electrical energy.
- 2. The names of the streets and parts of streets in which electrical lines are to be laid down within a specified time are as follows:—

Frinton Road from the boundary of the Urban District of Clacton and the Parish of Little Holland eastwards to Stratford Road, King's Avenue from Frinton Road to Madeira Road, Preston Road eastwards from King's Avenue for a distance of 50 yards, Bedford Road eastwards from King's Avenue for a distance of 75 yards, Salisbury Road eastwards from King's Avenue for a distance of 100 yards, Dulwich Road eastwards from King's Avenue for a distance of 150 yards, Madeira Road eastwards from Kings' Avenue for a distance of 160 yards.

3. The streets not repairable by the local authority which the Council propose to take special powers by the Order to break up are as follows:—

King's Avenue, The Grove, Princes Road, York Road, King's Parade, Madeira Road, Dulwich Road, Salisbury Road, Bedford Road, Preston Road, Colchester Road, Chelmsford Road, Coronation Road, Ipswich Road, Stratford Road, Brentwood Road, Slade Road, Nansen Road.

4. Every local or other public authority or person being desirous of bringing before the Electricity Commissioners any objection respecting the application may do so by registered letter addressed to the Secretary, Electricity Commission, Gwydyr House, Whitehall, S.W. 1, and despatched on or before the 14th day of July, 1925, and a copy of such objections must also be forwarded to the undermentioned Clerk to the Council or Parliamentary Agents.
