- 2. To authorise the Council to exercise all the powers usually conferred on distributors of electricity including showrooms and the supply of electricity by overhead mains.
- 3. To prescribe the price to be charged for the supply of electricity.
- 4. The streets and parts of streets in which it is proposed that electric lines shall be laid down within a period to be specified by the Order are as follows:—

Carr Vale:-

Main Street, Bathurst Road, Charlesworth Street and Railway Side Street.

Bolsover: --

Church Street, Castle Street, Market Place, Middle Street, High Street, Cotton Street from High Street to Town End, Town End.

5. The streets not repairable by the Council which the Council propose to take special powers by the Order to break up are as follows:—

Longlands, Sherwood Street, Orchard Row, Featherbed Lane and Bridle Lane.

Every local or other public authority company or person desirous of bringing before the Electricity Commissioners any objection respecting the application may do so by registered letter addressed to the Secretary, Electricity Commission, Savoy Court, Strand, London, W.C., and posted on or before the 15th day of July, 1925, and a copy of such objections must also be forwarded to the undersigned Parliamentary Agents.

(The supply of Electricity by the Corporation of Cheltenham in the Rural Districts of Tewkesbury and Winchcomb and part of the Rural District of Cheltenham, all in the County of Gloucester, and the laying of electric lines in the Borough of Tewkesbury, in the said County).

OTICE is hereby given that application is intended to be made by the Mayor, Aldermen, and Burgesses of the Borough of Cheltenham, whose address is The Municipal Offices, Cheltenham (hereinafter called "the Corporation") to the Electricity Commissioners for a Special Order (hereinafter called

- "the Order" under the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1922, for all or some of the following, amongst other purposes (that is to say):—
- 1. To extend the area of supply of the Corporation under the Cheltenham Electric Lighting Orders, 1890 to 1912, so as to include the following areas (hereinafter called "the added area") in the County of Gloucester (namely): The rural district of Tewkesbury; the rural district of Winchcomb (except the Chapelry of Cutsdean); and the parishes of Badgeworth, Cowley, Cubberley, Shurdington, Staverton, Swindon, Uckington, Up Hatherley, and Great Witcombe in the rural district of Cheltenham (hereinafter referred to as "the added area").
- 2. To authorise the Corporation to generate, supply, distribute, and sell electrical energy for all public and private purposes as defined by the Electricity (Supply) Acts 1882 to 1922 within the added area.
- 3. To extend and make applicable to the added area all or some of the provisions contained in the Cheltenham Electric Lighting Orders, 1890 to 1912, and to apply such provisions to the Undertaking to be authorised by the Order, subject to such variations and exceptions as may be contained therein.
- 4. To incorporate in the Order such of the provisions contained in the Schedule to the Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act, 1899, as are applicable.
- 5. To confer upon the Corporation all or some of the powers of the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1922, and enactments incorporated therein, and to alter, vary, or extinguish all rights and privileges which would or might interfere with any of the objects of the Order, and to confer all other rights and privileges necessary for carrying such objects into effect.
- 6. To prescribe the maximum price that may be demanded and taken by the Corporation in respect of the supply of electricity within the added area.
- 7. The following are the streets and parts of streets not repairable by the Local Authority which the Corporation propose to take powers to break up:—

(a) " County Roads ":—

In the Rural District of Cheltenham—Road from Cheltenham to Painswick, Road from Cheltenham to Birdlip, Road from Gloucester to Birdlip, Road from Gloucester to Andoversford, Road from Cheltenham to Colesborne, Road from Cheltenham to Tewkesbury, Road from Cheltenham to Gloucester, Road from Cheltenham to Gloucester, Road from Shurdington, via The Reddings, Bamfurlong, Golden Valley, and Arle, to the Cheltenham-Tewkesbury Road.

In the Rural District of Tewkesbury—Road from Gloucester to County boundary, via Tewkesbury, Road from Cheltenham to junction with last-named Road at Coombe Hill, Road from Hartpury to Tirley, Road from Ledbury to Tewkesbury, Road from Staunton to Cheltenham-Tewkesbury Road, via Haw Bridge, Road from Cheltenham to Bredon, Road from Evesham to last-named Road, Road from Tewkesbury to Stanway.
