THE LONDON TRAFFIC (RESTRICTED STREETS) (No. 2) PROVISIONAL REGULATIONS, 1925.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Transport by virtue and in exercise of the powers given to him by Section 7 of the London Traffic Act, 1924, and the London Traffic (Restricted Streets) (No. 2) Provisional Regulations, 1925, after consulting the London and Home Counties Traffic Advisory Committee, has relaxed the restrictions and limitations imposed by Regulation 2 of the said Regulations upon the occasion of the Royal Air Force Pageant to be held at Hendon Aerodrome on Saturday, the 27th day of June, 1925, so that nothing in the said Regulations shall prevent any person maintaining at the date of this Notice a regular service in accordance with Section 6 of the London Traffic Act, 1924, upon
