

thence to a point in Sea View Terrace near Tanybryn, Borthygest.

(2) From end of Garth Road south of Bronygarth House along the footpath therefrom to its connection with footpath from Wharves.

(b) County Roads:—

(1) Beddgelert Main Road from the Urban District boundary at Pwll-gloewlas to the Urban District boundary at Tanygraig.

(2) Penamser Main Road from the boundary at Wern to Park Square Portmadoc.

(3) Penamser Main Road from Penamser Terrace to its connection with Beddgelert Main Road near Tremadoc School.

(c) The roadways over the level crossings:—

(1) Over the Cambrian Railway of the Great Western Railway Company near the Portmadoc Railway Station.

(2) Over the Festiniog Railway between High Street and Cornhill.

(3) Over the Welsh Highland Railway at:—

(a) Madoc Street and

(b) Snowdon Street.

4. The names of the streets in which it is proposed that electric lines shall be laid down within a period to be specified by the Order, are as follows:—

Portmadoc:—

High Street, Snowdon Street, Madoc Street from Snowdon Street to Maen Offeren Office, Bank Place, Lombard Street from Bank Place up to but not including Cornhill, Garth Road from Lombard Street to Bryn Glaslyn, Chapel Street from High Street to Madoc Street and New Street from High Street to Madoc Street West.

Borth-y-Gest:—

Sea View Terrace from the north corner of the house known as Tanygarth to the south corner of the house known as "Bronafon."

Ralph Street from the north corner of the house known as "Bwthyn" to Mersey Street.

Mersey Street from No. 1 Sea View Terrace to Ralph Street

Tremadoc:—

Church Street from High Street to the south eastern corner of Peniel Calvinistic Methodist Chapel.

High Street from the south corner of Market Hall to the south eastern corner of the building known as "Portmadoc Steam Laundry."

5. To authorise the Council to take, collect and recover rates, rents and charges for the supply of electricity, and the sale or use of any

machine, lamps, meters, fittings or apparatus connected therewith, and to prescribe and limit the price to be charged for electricity.

6. To confer upon the Council all or some of the powers of the Electricity (Supply) Acts 1882 to 1922 and enactments incorporated therewith, to incorporate with the Order all or some of the provisions of the Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act 1899 subject to such variations, extensions and exceptions as will be contained therein and to alter, vary, or extinguish all rights and privileges which would or might interfere with any of the objects of the Order, and to confer all other rights and privileges necessary for carrying such objects into effect.

Printed copies of the draft Order as applied for and of the Order when made may be obtained (at the price of two shillings for each copy) at the offices of the undermentioned Solicitors and Parliamentary Agents.

Every local or other public authority, company or person being desirous of bringing before the Electricity Commissioners any objection respecting the application may do so by registered letter addressed to the Secretary, Electricity Commission, Gwydyr House, Whitehall, S.W. 1, and despatched before the 2nd day of September, 1925, and a copy of such objection must also be forwarded to the undersigned Solicitors or Parliamentary Agents.
