GLOUCESTER ELECTRICITY  
(EXTENSION).

SPECIAL ORDER.

(The supply of electricity by the Corporation of Gloucester in the Rural District of Gloucester in the County of Gloucester.)

**N**OTICE is hereby given that the Mayor, Aldermen, and Citizens of the City of Gloucester in the County of the City of Gloucester (hereinafter called "the Corporation") whose address is Guildhall, Gloucester, intend to apply to the Electricity Commission for a Special Order (hereinafter called "the Order") under the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1922, for all or some of the following (amongst other) purposes (that is to say):—

1.—To extend the area of the Corporation for the supply of electricity by adding thereto the rural district of Gloucester in the County of Gloucester, hereinafter called "the added area."

2.—To authorise the Corporation to generate, supply, distribute, and sell electricity for all public and private purposes as defined by the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1922, within the added area.

3.—To extend and make applicable to the added area all or some of the provisions contained in the Gloucester Corporation Electric Supply Order, 1896, and the Gloucester Corporation Act, 1911, and to apply such provisions to the undertaking to be authorised by the Order, subject to such variations and exceptions as may be contained therein.

4.—To confer further powers upon the Corporation in regard to the supply of electrical energy to railways, tramways and canals for incidental purposes.

5.—To incorporate in the Order such of the provisions contained in the Schedule to the Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act, 1899, as are applicable.

6.—To prescribe the maximum price that may be demanded and taken by the Corporation in respect of the supply of electricity within the added area.

7.—The street in the added area in which it is proposed that electric lines shall be laid down within a period to be specified by the Order is the Main road from the boundary of the City at Wotton to Barnwood House.

8.—The streets and parts of streets not repairable by the Local Authority railways and tramways which the Corporation propose to take specific powers to break up are:—

(a) *County Roads*:—

In the Rural District of Gloucester:—

- Road from Gloucester to Bristol.
- Road from Gloucester to Huntley.
- Road from Minsterworth to last-mentioned road.
- Road from Gloucester to Newent.
- Road from Gloucester to Hartpury.
- Road from Gloucester to Tewkesbury.
- Road from Gloucester to Cheltenham.
- Road from Gloucester to Birdlip.
- Road from Gloucester to Stroud via Tuffley.

- Road from Gloucester to Painswick.
- Road from Longford to Longlevens.
- Road from Cheltenham to Painswick.

(b) *Roadways on and approaches to the following Bridges over Railways*:—

In the Rural District of Gloucester:—

The Great Western Railway:—

On the road from Huntley to Gloucester over main line.

On the road from Huntley to Gloucester over the branch line from Gloucester to Ledbury.

By Churchdown Station.

At Churchdown (Sugar-loaf).

(c) *Roadways under the following Railway Bridges*:—

In the Rural District of Gloucester:—

The Great Western Railway:—

At Tuffley by Tuffley Farm.

At Tuffley by Tuffley Court.

At Barnwood (on main road).

At Churchdown (Brookfield).

The London, Midland and Scottish Railway:—

At Tuffley by Tuffley Farm.

At Barnwood (on main road).

At Churchdown (Brookfield).
