PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AMENDMENT ACT, 1907.

NOTICE is hereby given that by an Order dated the 4th day of July, 1925, the Minister of Health has confirmed an Order made on the thirty-first day of May, 1925, by the Lord Mayor Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Leeds, acting by the Council, in pursuance of Section 112 of the Public Health Act 1875, as amended by Section 51 of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act 1907, declaring each of the trades of a tanner, a leather dresser, a fat melter or fat extractor, a glue maker, a size maker, a gut scraper, a rag and bone dealer, a fish frier, and a manufacturer of manure from fish, fish offal, blood or other putrescible animal matter within the City to be an offensive trade.

A copy of the Order may be inspected at the Town Clerk's Office, 11, Park Square, Leeds, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. on Saturdays and between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on other weekdays.

THE WATER UNDERTAKINGS (MODIFICATION OF CHARGES) ACT, 1921.

CHELTENHAM CORPORATION.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO THE MINISTER OF HEALTH.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the borough of Cheltenham (hereinafter called "the Corporation") have made application to the Minister of Health under the above Act for an Order modifying the provisions of Section 70 of the Cheltenham Corporation Water Act, 1878, as altered by Act IV of the Provisional Order of the Local Government Board dated the 22nd May, 1883 relating to Cheltenham so as to authorise the Corporation to demand and take in respect of a supply of water for domestic purposes (including Water Closets) at a rate not exceeding 7 per cent. per annum on the gross estimated rental of the premises supplied with water with a minimum of 10s. for any dwellinghouse or part of a dwellinghouse and to modify the provisions of Sub-sections (b) and (c) of Section 59 of the said Act of 1878 and of Section 85 of the said Act so as to provide that the annual sums which may be required to be paid by the Urban District of Charlton Kings to the Corporation in respect of the expense of providing and laying down additional mains pipes hydrants and fire plugs at the request of the said Urban District Council and the annual sums which shall be paid by the Corporation of Tewkesbury to the Corporation in respect of the net outlay incurred by the Corporation in laying down additional pipes at the request of the Tewkesbury Corporation for the supply in bulk within the

Borough of Tewkesbury shall not at any time exceed by more than 50 per cent. of the sums respectively prescribed by the said Sub-sections of Section 59 and by Section 85 of the said Act.

A copy of the Application and of all documents submitted to the Minister in connection therewith may be inspected and extracts thereof made free of charge at the Municipal Offices, Cheltenham, between the hours of 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. on weekdays (except Saturdays) and on Saturdays between the hours of 10 a.m. and 1 p.m.

Any person desiring to make any representation or objection with reference to the Application may do so by letter addressed to the Secretary, Ministry of Health, Whitehall, London, S.W. 1, not later than the 18th August, 1925. A copy of any such representation or objection must be sent at the same time to the undersigned.

WATER UNDERTAKINGS (MODIFICATION OF CHARGES) ACT, 1921.

SELSEY WATER COMPANY.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Selsey Water Company have made application to the Minister of Health under the above Act for an Order modifying Sections 26, 27 and 28 of the Selsey Water Act 1907 so as to enable them to make charges for water supply for domestic purposes, for meter supplies and for public purposes in the water limits within which they are empowered to supply water, as follows:—

1. Supply for domestic purposes:—

Where the rateable value of the premises so supplied does not exceed five pounds per annum the sum of thirteen shillings per annum.

Where such rateable value exceeds five pounds but does not exceed twenty pounds per annum the rate of fifteen pounds per centum per annum upon such value;

Where such rateable value exceeds twenty pounds but does not exceed forty pounds the rate of thirteen pounds ten shillings per centum per annum upon such value;

Where such rateable value exceeds forty pounds but does not exceed sixty pounds the rate of twelve pounds per centum per annum upon such value;

Where such rateable value exceeds sixty pounds but does not exceed eighty pounds the rate of ten pounds ten shillings per centum upon such value;
