CONWAY ELECTRICITY (EXTENSION) SPECIAL  
ORDER, 1925.

NOTICE is hereby given, that the Electricity Commissioners have submitted to the Minister of Transport for confirmation under the above-mentioned Acts a Special Order made by them for the supply by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Conway of electricity within parts of the Parishes of Llechwedd Llangelynin and Llangwstenin, in the Rural District of Conway, in the County of Carnarvon.

The Minister of Transport proposes to confirm the Order, and gives notice that any person affected who may be desirous of objecting to the confirmation of the same must, in accordance with the Electricity (Confirmation of Special Orders) Rules, 1921, do so by memorial addressed to the Minister of Transport, written on one side only of foolscap paper, and sent by registered post addressed to The Secretary, Ministry of Transport, 6, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W. 1, and posted not later than the 12th day of

September, 1925. A copy of any such memorial must also be sent, in like manner, to Messrs. Porter and Company, Plas Vardre, Conway, Solicitors, or to Messrs. Lees and Company, Palace Chambers, Bridge Street, Westminster, London, S.W. 1, Parliamentary Agents for the Order. Such memorial must be sealed or signed by the person objecting, or by some responsible and duly authorised person on his behalf, and must state the specific grounds of objection to the Order and the modifications desired.

Copies of the Order, as submitted for confirmation, may be obtained at a price not exceeding two shillings each at the office of Mr. E. O. Foulkes, Assistant Surveyor, situate at Llys Iorwerth, Ronald Avenue, Llandudno Junction, at the Municipal Offices, Conway, and at the offices of the before mentioned Solicitors and Parliamentary Agents.
