

Annfield Plain; Saint Peter, Auckland; Belmont; Saint John, Darlington; Eldon; Eppleton; The Venerable Bede, Gateshead; Saint John the Baptist, Hamsteels; Saint Oswald, Hebburn; Hedworth; Holmside; Kimblesworth; Lyons; Saint Cuthbert, Marley Hill; Saint Mary Magdalene, Millfield; Saint Peter, Sacriston; Saint Oswald, Shiney Row; Saint Jude, South Shields; Saint Oswin, South Shields; Saint Simon, South Shields; Saint James, Stockton upon Tees; Saint Paul, Stockton upon Tees; and Witton Park (in testimony of which consent he, the said Bishop, has affixed his signature and Episcopal Seal to this Scheme) and with the consent of the Right Honourable Stanley Baldwin, now First Lord of Your Majesty's Treasury, acting on behalf of Your Majesty as the alternate Patron of each of the said twenty-two Benefices of Beamish; Benfieldside; Saint Aidan, Blackhill; Cassop cum Quarrington; Castleside; Chilton Moor; Consett; Cornforth; Coxhoe; Saint John the Evangelist, Dipton; Evenwood; Fir Tree; Saint John, Hebburn; Leadgate; Saint Paul, Low Team; All Saints, Monkwearmouth; Saint Aidan, South Shields; Saint Francis, South Shields; Saint Mark, South Shields; South Westoe; Saint Cuthbert, Stella; and Saint Peter, Stockton upon Tees (in testimony of which consent he, the said Stanley Baldwin, has signed and sealed this Scheme), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, humbly recommend and propose that upon and from the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme and without any conveyance or assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order the alternate right of Patronage of and presentation to each of the said twenty-three Benefices of Saint Aidan, Annfield Plain; Saint Peter, Auckland; Belmont; Saint John, Darlington; Eldon; Eppleton; The Venerable Bede, Gateshead; Saint John the Baptist, Hamsteels; Saint Oswald, Hebburn; Hedworth; Holmside; Kimblesworth; Lyons; Saint Cuthbert, Marley Mill; Saint Mary Magdalene,

Millfield; Saint Peter, Sacriston; Saint Oswald, Shiney Row; Saint Jude, South Shields; Saint Oswin, South Shields; Saint Simon, South Shields; Saint James, Stockton upon Tees; Saint Paul, Stockton upon Tees; and Witton Park which is now as aforesaid exercised by the said Herbert Hensley, Bishop of Durham, shall be transferred from him, the said Bishop, and from his successors in the same Bishopric and shall thereupon and thenceforth belong to and may from time to time be exercised by Your Majesty, Your Heirs and Successors for ever in such manner that the whole Advowson of each of the said twenty-three Benefices shall hereafter belong to Your Majesty, Your Heirs and Successors for ever, and that in exchange for the same the alternate right of Patronage of and presentation to each of the said twenty-two Benefices of Beamish; Benfieldside; Saint Aidan, Blackhill; Cassop cum Quarrington; Castleside; Chilton Moor; Consett; Cornforth; Coxhoe; Saint John the Evangelist, Dipton; Evenwood; Fir Tree; Saint John, Hebburn; Leadgate; Saint Paul, Low Team; All Saints, Monkwearmouth; Saint Aidan, South Shields; Saint Francis, South Shields; Saint Mark, South Shields; South Westoe; Saint Cuthbert, Stella; and Saint Peter, Stockton upon Tees, which is now exercised as aforesaid by Your Majesty, shall be transferred from Your Majesty, Your Heirs and Successors, and shall thereupon and thenceforth belong to and may from time to time be exercised by the said Herbert Hensley, Bishop of Durham, and his successors, Bishops of Durham, for ever in such manner that the whole Advowson of each of the said twenty-two Benefices shall hereafter belong to the said Herbert Hensley, Bishop of Durham, and his successors, Bishops of Durham, for ever.

"And we further recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, in accordance with the provisions of the said Acts, or of either of them, or of any other Act of Parliament."
