And whereas We deem it expedient that Chaplains of Our Army belonging to the Church of England shall, for the furtherance of their duties, receive an episcopal licence similar to that which is granted by Bishops to officiating clergy within their dioceses:

Our will and pleasure is that all Chaplains belonging to the Church of England shall, after appointment for service with Our Army, receive a special ecclesiastical licence or permission from the Archbishop of Canterbury and his successors, such licence or permission to be capable of recognition by all Bishops and other authority of the Church of England throughout the world during the period that such Chaplains shall be on the active list of Our Army.

Given at Our Court at St. James's this 31st day of July, 1925, in the sixteenth year of Our Reign.
