

Foreign Animals Quarantine Station for the purpose of the detention of the animals described in the First Schedule hereto.

Examination before Landing.

3. No such animals as aforesaid shall be landed except with a licence granted by an Inspector of the Ministry, which licence shall not be granted unless and until the animals have been examined by a Veterinary Inspector of the Ministry and certified by him to be free from symptoms of contagious disease.

Regulations Applicable to the Animals on Landing.

4. The animals, on being landed, shall forthwith be moved under the supervision of an Inspector of the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries from the quay to the premises described in the Second Schedule hereto, and shall be there detained for a period of twenty-eight days.

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 2ND SEPTEMBER, 1925.)

HAMPSHIRE (SOUTHAMPTON AND DISTRICT) FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE INFECTED AREA ORDER OF 1925 (No. 3).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1925, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Contraction of Infected Area.

1. The Hampshire (Southampton and District) Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area Order of 1925 shall be read and have effect as if the Area described in the Schedule to this Order were substituted for the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area described in the Schedule to that Order.

Revocation.

2. The Hampshire (Southampton and District) Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area Order of 1925 (No. 2) is hereby revoked.

Commencement.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the sixth day of September, 1925.

Short Title.

4. This Order may be cited as the HAMPSHIRE (SOUTHAMPTON AND DISTRICT) FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE INFECTED AREA ORDER OF 1925 (No. 3), and shall be read with the Order referred to in Article 1.
