#### ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 22ND SEPTEMBER, 1925.)

#### FOREIGN HAY AND STRAW (AMENDMENT) ORDER OF 1925 (No. 3).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts,

1894 to 1925, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

#### *Prohibition of Landing of Hay and Straw from certain parts of United States of America.*

1. Hay and Straw brought from such parts of the United States of America as are described in the Schedule hereto shall be subject to the prohibition of landing contained in the Foreign Hay and Straw Order of 1912.

#### *Revocation.*

2. The Foreign Hay and Straw (Amendment) Order of 1925 (No. 2) is hereby revoked.

#### *Commencement.*

3. This Order shall take immediate effect, provided that such prohibition shall not apply to hay and straw shipped from the States of New Mexico, Colorado, Kansas, Oklahoma, Arkansas and Louisiana before the date of this Order.

#### *Short Title.*

4. This Order may be cited as the FOREIGN HAY AND STRAW (AMENDMENT) ORDER OF 1925 (No. 3).

In witness whereof the Official Seal of the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries is hereunto affixed this twenty-second day of September, nineteen hundred and twenty-five.

#### ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 22ND SEPTEMBER, 1925.)

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1925, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. The Foreign Animals Order of 1910 and any Order amending it shall be read and have effect as if such parts of the United States of America as are described in the Schedule hereto were included in the Prohibited Countries and Parts of Countries specified in the First Schedule to the first-mentioned Order.

#### *Revocation.*

2. The Order of the Minister (No. 3997) dated the first day of August, nineteen hundred and twenty-five, declaring the States of California and Texas in the United States of America, to be a Scheduled Country for the purposes of the Foreign Animals Order of 1910, is hereby revoked.
