ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES. (DATED 17TH OCTOBER, 1925.)

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1925, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. An Inspector of the Ministry, with a view to prevent the spread of Foot-and-Mouth Disease may by notice require the removal to a convenient and isolated place approved by him of any animal now at the British Dairy Farmers' Association Show at the Royal Agricultural Hall, Islington, in the county of London, which has been brought from the Foot-and-Mouth Disease infected area declared by order of the Minister dated 17th October, 1925, and entitled the Sussex and Surrey Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area Order of
