APPOINTMENTS.

On 6th October, 1925 :—

WHITEHALL, S.W.
DOWNING STREET

Eight Hackney Carriages :
In the centre of roadway, commencing at a point 18 yards North of Refuge in Whitehall, at junction of Downing Street, and extending Northward as far as necessary for eight carriages.
Front of vehicles toward the South.

On 8th October, 1925 :—

BRIGHTON ROAD, SUTTON

Twenty Hackney Carriages :
First Portion.—Two carriages to stand on East side of roadway, by kerb, at a point 6 feet from lamp-post at entrance to Sutton Railway Station.
Front of vehicles toward the North.
NOTE.—Of the two carriages on this portion, one shall be mechanically propelled, and the other horse drawn.
Second Portion.—Eighteen carriages to stand on West side of roadway, commencing at a point 17 yards from junction with Mulgrave Road, Sutton, extending Southward, by kerb, as far as necessary for eighteen carriages.
Front of vehicles toward the North.
The first portion of the Standing to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion.

On 9th October, 1925 :—

TOOTING BEC GARDENS,
STREATHAM

Four Hackney Carriages :
On West side of roadway, commencing at street lamp-post No. 2767, and extending Northward, along kerb by the blank wall of "Russell House," as far as necessary for four carriages."
Front of vehicles toward the South.
