Under the provisions of the Mining Industry Act, 1920, and of the Factory and Workshop Act, 1901, Colonel Lane Fox has further appointed Mr. Richardson to be an Inspector of Factories and Workshops for the purposes of the Factory and Workshop Act, 1901, so far as it applies to quarries and pitbanks as defined in Part II of the Sixth Schedule to that Act.
