The following Statute made by the University of Oxford Commissioners, for the University of Oxford, and sealed on the 6th day of November, 1925, has been submitted for the approval of His Majesty in Council, and notice of its having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of "The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923":—

WE, the University of Oxford Commissioners under and by virtue of all and every the powers in this behalf enabling us contained in the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923, have, at a meeting at which more than three members were present, made the Statute hereunto annexed for the University of Oxford concerning the power of the Vice-Chancellor to appoint Chairmen for meetings of Boards, Delegacies, or Committees, being a Statute wholly for the University.

Given under our Common Seal this sixth day of November, in the year of Our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five.

Statute amending Statt. Tit. XVII, Sect III, §1.

After clause 6 the following new clause shall be inserted:—

" 7. The Vice-Chancellor may, if he think fit,

(i) Save in the case of the General Board of the Faculties appoint a Pro-Vice-Chancellor or any Member of a Board, Delegacy, or Committee to act for him as Chairman at any meeting of such Board, Delegacy, or Committee which he himself may be unable to attend.

(ii) Save in the case of any body of which the Vice-Chancellor is by Statute expressly stated to be Chairman and of the Visitatorial Board, appoint any Pro-Vice-Chancellor or a Member of a Board, Delegacy, or Committee to act for him during his tenure of office of Vice-Chancellor, or any portion thereof, as Chairman of that Board, Delegacy, or Committee, provided that the Vice-Chancellor may preside as Chairman at any meeting of such Board, Delegacy, or Committee at which he may deem it expedient that he himself should preside."
