LINCOLNSHIRE (LINDSEY AND DISTRICT) FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREA) ORDER OF 1925.

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1925, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Declaration of Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area.

1. The area described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be a Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area for the purposes of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1925.

Commencement and Short Title.

2. This Order shall take immediate effect and may be cited as the LINCOLNSHIRE (LINDSEY AND DISTRICT) FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREA) ORDER OF 1925.

MIDLANDS AND SOUTH OF ENGLAND (REGULATION OF MOVEMENT OF ANIMALS) ORDER OF 1925 (No. 2).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1925, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Extension of "Regulated Area" to which the Midlands and South of England (Regulation of Movement of Animals) Order of 1925 applies.

1. The Midlands and South of England (Regulation of Movement of Animals) Order of 1925 shall be read and have effect as if the Parts of Lindsey Division of Lincolnshire were
