FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE DECLARATION OF INFECTED AREAS ORDER OF 1925 (No. 15).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1925, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Declaration of Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Areas.

1. The areas described in the First Schedule to this Order are hereby declared to be Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Areas for the purposes of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1925, as modified by the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Temporary Modification of Restrictions) Order of 1925.

Revocation of Certain Orders.

2. The Orders described in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby revoked.

Commencement.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-fifth day of December, nineteen hundred and twenty-five.

Short Title.

4. This Order may be cited as the FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE DECLARATION OF INFECTED AREAS ORDER OF 1925 (No. 15).

FIRST SCHEDULE.

1. An Area comprising:—

In the county of Lancaster.

The county boroughs of Blackburn and Preston.

The boroughs of Acerington, Clitheroe and Darwen.

The petty sessional divisions of Amounderness, Walton-le-Dale, Clitheroe, Burnley (except the parishes of Briercliffe, Worsthorne with Hurstwood, Cliviger, Habbergham Eaves and Dunnoekshaw, but not excluding its detached part), Colne (except the detached part of the parish of Foulridge, and the parish of Trawden), Blackburn, Darwen, Church, and the parishes of Penwortham, Howick, Farington, Clayton-le-Woods, Cuerden, Wheelton, Withnell, Brindle and Hoghton.

In the county of the West Riding of Yorkshire.

The petty sessional division of Bolton-by-Bowland, and the parishes of Tosside,

Wigglesworth, Halton West, Swinden, Nappa, Newsholme, Bank Newton, Marton's Both, Bracewell, Brogden, Barnoldswick and Salterforth.

2. An Area comprising:—

In the county of Stafford.

The city of Stoke-on-Trent.

The boroughs of Newcastle-under-Lyme and Stafford.

The petty sessional divisions of Pirehill North (except the parishes of Balterley, Betley, Audley, Hardings Wood, Kidsgrove, Newchapel, Norton-in-the-Moors and Bagnall), Eccleshall, Stone (except the parishes of Fulford and Milwich) and Stafford (except the parishes of Gayton, Fradswell, Chartley Holme, Stowe, Colwich, Brocton, Baswich, Tixall, Ingestre and Weston-upon-Trent).

In the county of Salop.

The petty sessional divisions of Drayton (excluding its detached part), and Newport (except the parishes of Himmersley, Preston-upon-the-Weald Moors, Lilleshall, St. George's and Sheriff Hales).

3. An Area comprising:—

In the county of Stafford.

The county borough of Wolverhampton.

The petty sessional divisions of Wolverhampton (except the parishes of Swindon and Essington) and Bilston, and such part of the parish of Brewood as lies to the south of the following boundary:—Commencing at the parish boundary near Deepmore Mill, thence along the right bank of the River Penk to the point where it adjoins the road from Brewood to Lower Green and thence along the road which leads direct to Renschaw Wood via Lower Avenue, Upper Avenue and Chillington Hall.

In the county of Salop.

The parishes of Rudge, Boningale and Albrighton including its detached part.

4. An Area comprising:—

In the county of Derby.

The county borough of Derby.

The petty sessional divisions of Derby (except the parishes of Spondon, Ockbrook, Hopwell, Risley, Long Eaton, Sawley and Wilsthorpe, Breaston, Shardlow and Great Wilne, Weston-upon-Trent, Aston-upon-Trent, Elvaston and Draycott and Church Wilne), Appletree (Sudbury) and the parishes of Holbrook, Milford, Duffield, Hazelwood, Windley, Turnditch, Mercaston, Hulland Ward, Hulland Ward Intakes, Hulland, Bradley, Sturston, Yeldersley, Brailsford, Osmaston, Snelston, Yeaveley, Edlaston and Wyaston, Rodsley, Shirley, Hollington, Longford and Osleston and Thurstaston.

5. An Area comprising:—

In the county of Leicester.

The parishes of Old Dalby, Ragdale, Thrussington, Hoby, Shoby, Grinston, Saxelby, Wartnaby, Kettleby, Welby, Sysonby, Asfordby, Rotherby, Brooksby, Frisby on the Wreak, Kirby Bellars, Eye Kettleby, Melton Mowbray, Thorpe Arnold, Burton Lazars, Little Dalby, Great Dalby,
