SCARBOROUGH.

Whereas the Mayor, Aldermen, and Burgesses of the Borough of Scarborough (hereinafter called the Corporation), being the Urban Sanitary Authority for the said Borough, have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order under Sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act, 1875, partially to repeal, alter or amend the Scarborough Water Acts, 1845 and 1878, the Scarborough Corporation Water Act, 1878, the Scarborough Corporation Act, 1900, and the Scarborough Corporation Act, 1925, so as:—

(1) To authorise the Corporation to sink a well and to erect a pumping station and subsidiary works in connection therewith on a site belonging to them containing four acres or thereabouts, being field number 23 on the Ordnance Survey Map (1889 Survey) in the Parish of Irton in the administrative county of the North Riding of Yorkshire;

(2) To authorise the construction of a new service reservoir on land belonging to the Corporation at Spring Hill in the borough of Scarborough containing five acres and thirty poles or thereabouts, being field number 273 on the Ordnance Survey Map (1890 Survey);

(3) To authorise the laying of a new main from the proposed new well to the proposed new service reservoir;

(4) To enable the Corporation to borrow the sum of £55,000 for the purpose of the said works and to borrow with the sanction of the Ministry of Health such further sums as may from time to time be required for the above purpose and generally for the purpose of their water undertaking;

(5) To apply the powers of Section 54 of the Public Health Act, 1875, for the laying of water mains within and without the limits of supply;

(6) To provide that byelaws as to stopping places for omnibuses made under the powers of Section 81 or the Scarborough Corporation Act, 1925, shall be confirmed by the Minister of Health instead of by the Secretary of State;

(7) For the several purposes of the Application or for purposes connected with, incidental to, or consequent on those purposes to make any such alteration or amendment of the said Local Acts, or of any other Local Act or of any Act confirming a Provisional Order made in pursuance of any of the Sanitary Acts or of the Public Health Act, 1875, in force in the said Borough as may be necessary or desirable.
