GEORGE STREET, W.

Three Hackney Carriages:

On South side of roadway, commencing at a point 15 feet from the building line at East side of Manchester Street, and extending Eastward, by kerb, as far as necessary for three carriages.

Front of vehicles toward the West.

KENSINGTON ROAD, W. (In three portions) Twenty-three Hackney Carriages:

First Portion.—Seven carriages, on North side of roadway, commencing at a point four yards East of Cabmen's Shelter, extending Eastward, by kerb, as far as necessary for seven carriages.

Front of vehicles toward the West.

Second Portion.—Ten carriages, on North side of roadway, commencing at a point 45 yards East of Broad Walk entrance to Kensington Gardens, extending Eastward, by kerb, as far as necessary for ten carriages.

Front of vehicles toward the West.

Third Portion.—Six carriages, on North side of roadway, commencing at a point three yards East of Eastern Water Trough, extending Eastward, by kerb, as far as necessary for six carriages.

On East side of roadway, commencing at a point 15 feet from the kerb at South side of Marylebone Road and extending Southward, by kerb, as far as necessary for two carriages, keeping clear of the Bank premises, viz., 154, Harley Street. Front of vehicles toward the North.
