THE PITCH (EMERGENCY: PROHIBITION OF EXPORT) ORDER, 1926, DATED 5TH OCTOBER, 1926, MADE BY THE BOARD OF TRADE UNDER THE EMERGENCY REGULATIONS (No. 6) 1926.

The Board of Trade in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by the Emergency Regulations (No. 6) 1926 (S.R. & O. 1926, No. 1130) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby order as follows:—

1. The shipment of pitch for exportation, except under such conditions as the Board of Trade may by their licence allow, is hereby prohibited.

2. This Order may be cited as the Pitch (Emergency: Prohibition of Export) Order, 1926.
