

APPOINTMENTS FOR STANDINGS FOR  
TWO HACKNEY CARRIAGES.

*By virtue of the Act 13 and 14 Victoria, Chapter 7, intituled "An Act for Consolidating the Office of the Registrar of Metropolitan Public Carriages with the Office of Commissioners of Police of the Metropolis, and making other Provisions in regard to the Consolidated Offices."*

I, WILLIAM THOMAS FRANCIS HORWOOD, Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, do hereby APPOINT a Standing for two Hackney Carriages at Longmead Road, Tooting, in two portions, and do make the following Regulations with regard to the Boundaries for the same, viz. :—

*First Portion.*—One carriage on the South-east side of roadway, to stand at a point 20 yards North-east from the junction with Mitcham Road.

Front of vehicle toward the South-west.

*Second Portion.*—One carriage in the centre of roadway, to stand at a point 2 yards North-east of lamp-post by junction with Ashvale Road.

Front of vehicle toward the South-west.

The first portion of the Standing to be fed exclusively from the second portion.

Provided that no Hackney Carriage shall be suffered to stand across any Street or Thoroughfare, or opposite the end of any Street or Carriageway, or upon any place where Foot Passengers usually cross the Carriageway.
