ELECTRICITY.

Application for Special Order under the
Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1922.

NOTICE is hereby given that application has been made by the Electric Supply Corporation Limited (herein called "the Undertakers") whose address for the purposes of such application is at 424, Salisbury House, London Wall, London, E.C. 2, to the Electricity Commissioners under the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1922, for a Special Order for the following among other purposes, that is to say:—

1. To authorise the Undertakers to generate, take, transform, supply, sell, and distribute electricity for all public and private purposes as defined by the above Acts within the following area (hereinafter referred to as the "area of supply") that is to say: the Parishes of Pyecombe, Hurstpierpoint, Clayton Keymer and Albourne in the Rural District of Cuckfield, and the parish of Ditchling in the rural district of Chailey, except such parts of the said parishes as are already included in the area of supply under the Burgess Hill and District Special Order 1924 all in the administrative County of East Sussex.

2. To authorise the Undertakers or any such transferee as is hereinafter mentioned to exercise within the area of supply all the powers usually conferred on the distributors of electricity.

3. To incorporate with the Order all or some of the provisions of the Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act, 1899, subject to such variations and exceptions as may be contained therein.

4. To empower the Undertakers to break up streets outside area of supply for the purpose
