The Coal (Emergency) Supplementary (No. 5) Directions, 1926:

Provided that there shall be saved and excepted from this revocation the following Parts and Articles of the Principal Directions, that is to say—

The whole of Parts V and VII, Articles 21 and 22 of Part VI, and Articles 37, 38, 43 and 44 of Part IX, together with the definition of "coal" in Article 42.

(2) The interpretation Act, 1889, applies to the interpretation of these Directions as it applies to an Act of Parliament, and as if these Directions were an Act of Parliament.

(3) These Directions may be cited as the Coal (Emergency) Supplementary (No. 6) Directions, 1926, and shall come into force on the 25th day of November, 1926, so far as they relate to Parts III and VIII of the Principal Directions, and in respect of the remaining revocations on the 28th day of November, 1926.
