

open spaces) for purposes of intended works and for the purpose of an open space or recreation ground and for the extension of the Sewage Works of the Corporation; special provisions as to compensation to be paid; powers of retaining or disposing of surplus lands; power to lay out and develop such lands and erect sell let or otherwise dispose of buildings on such lands; agreements with landowners for reinstatement or exchange.

Provisions requiring the Manchester Ship Canal Company (hereinafter referred to as "the Canal Company") to lay certain lands of the Canal Company into Ordsall Lane in the City and to make up and flag the same as a footpath; provisions as to payments to be made by the Corporation to the Canal Company and by the Canal Company to the Corporation on the completion of such making up and flagging; powers to the Corporation in default of the Canal Company to lay the said lands into the said street and make up and flag the same as a footpath and provisions as to deduction to be made in that event from the sum payable by the Corporation to the Canal Company; provisions constituting the said lands part of the said street when laid into the same and provisions as to maintenance repair cleansing and lighting thereof.

Power to the Corporation to appropriate and use for educational purposes and erect buildings on the Grosvenor Square Recreation Ground in the City and extinguishment of rights therein.

Power to the Corporation to run omnibuses on routes wholly or partly outside the City; tolls rates fares and charges; provisions as to adaptation or strengthening of roads comprised in omnibus routes; power to let omnibuses for private hire; provisions constituting the omnibuses and intended powers part of the omnibus and tramway undertaking of the Corporation and application thereto of powers of the Corporation with reference to omnibuses or tramways; agreements with local authorities companies bodies and persons as to working user management and maintenance of omnibuses; exemption from liability to claims for damage by extraordinary traffic in respect of running of omnibuses; agreements with local authorities companies bodies or persons as to formation of junctions between tramways and leasing working running over using maintaining and managing of tramways of the parties.

Powers to the Corporation of controlling the erection or maintenance of advertising signs on lands buildings or other premises in the City; prohibiting the erection of wooden or other structures or erections of a movable or temporary character without the consent of the Corporation; extension of distances for which drivers of hackney carriages may be required to take passengers goods and messages under the Salford Corporation Act 1862 and the Salford Corporation Act 1920; amendment of provisions as to suspension or revocation of licences of proprietors or drivers of hackney carriages under Salford Improvement Act 1862 and Salford Tramways and Improvements Act 1875.

Further powers to the Corporation with reference to their electricity undertaking including powers and provisions with reference to the supply of electricity to premises partly within and partly without the electricity

limits; the use for the supply to other consumers of transformers provided for the supply to a particular consumer; extension of powers of entry on premises supplied or formerly supplied with electricity; cutting off of supplies where charges or sums due to the Corporation are not wholly paid; bylaws with reference to apparatus and fittings for supply of electricity; prohibiting the use for certain purposes of electricity supplied for other purposes; discontinuance of supply of electricity where used contrary to the terms of any agreement; fitting up of showrooms and offices and giving of demonstrations; recovery of cost of cutting off and reconnecting supplies in certain cases; payment to be made to or by the Corporation in respect of electricity supplied through a meter found to register erroneously; fitting of brackets etc. to buildings or bridges; acquisitions of undertakings of other authorised undertakers; rights of the Corporation with respect to electric lines or wires installed by them in case of sale or other disposition of the premises.

Further powers as to recovery of sums payable to the Corporation in respect of the provision etc. of fittings apparatus or appliances in connection with the supply or use of gas water or electricity.

Additional borrowing powers and other financial provisions.

Duplicate plans and sections showing the line, situation and level of the proposed works and the lands in, through or over which they will be made, and plans showing the lands which may be taken or used compulsorily under the powers of the Bill, together with a book of reference to such plans containing the names of the owners or reputed owners lessees or reputed lessees and of the occupiers of such lands will be deposited for public inspection on or before the 30th day of November instant with the Clerk of the Peace for the County Palatine of Lancaster at his office at Preston; and on or before the same day a copy of the said plans sections and book of reference will be deposited with the Town Clerk of the City at his office at the Town Hall Salford.

Printed copies of the Bill will be deposited in the Private Bill Office of the House of Commons on or before the 17th day of December next and on and after the 21st day of December next a copy of the Bill may be inspected and copies thereof may be obtained at the price of five shillings each at the offices of the undersigned.

A Notice stating the objects of the Bill has been or will be published in full on the 20th and 27th days of November instant in the "Salford City Reporter" Newspaper.
