

(6) To empower the Corporation to provide receptacles for refuse and to borrow money for the purpose;

(7) For the several purposes of the Application or for purposes connected with, incidental to, or consequent on those purposes to make any such alteration or amendment of the said Local Act, or of any other Local Act or of any Act confirming a Provisional Order made in pursuance of any of the Sanitary Acts or of the Public Health Act, 1875, and in force in the said Borough as may be necessary or desirable.

BOURNEMOUTH.

Whereas the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Bournemouth (hereinafter called the Corporation), being the Urban Sanitary Authority for the said Borough, have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order under Sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act, 1875, partially to repeal, alter or amend the Bournemouth Improvement Act, 1856, and the Bournemouth Improvement Act, 1892, so as to enable the Corporation to make byelaws under the general law as to certain matters now dealt with under the said local Acts. With this object, it is proposed:—

(1) To repeal section 22 of the said Local Act of 1856 in so far as the said section incorporates the following sections of the Towns Improvement Clauses Act, 1847, namely:—

Section 33 (as to ventilation of sewers and drains).

Sections 36 to 41 (as to drainage of houses).

Sections 42 and 43 (in so far as those sections require any ashpit or privy to be constructed to the satisfaction of the Corporation).

Sections 57 to 60 (as to laying out new streets).

Section 63 (as to width of new streets).

Sections 84 to 86 (in so far as those sections relate to procedure in connection with or consequent upon the fixing of the level of any new street).

Section 109 (as to the construction of houses).

(2) To repeal section 16 of the said Local Act of 1892 (as to pipes from sinks).

(3) For the several purposes of the Application or for purposes connected with, incidental to, or consequent on those purposes to make any such alteration or amendment of the said Local Act, or of any other Local Act or of any Act confirming a Provisional Order made in pursuance of any of the Sanitary Acts or of the Public Health Act, 1875, and in force in the said Borough as may be necessary or desirable:

And whereas it is proposed that a Provisional Order should be issued in compliance with the said Application;

LANCASTER.

Whereas the Mayor, Aldermen, and Burgesses of the Borough of Lancaster (hereinafter called the Corporation), being the Urban Sanitary Authority for the said Borough, have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order under Sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act, 1875, partially to repeal, alter or amend the Lancaster Corporation Act, 1918, so as:—

(1) To enable the Corporation to exercise with respect to surplus lands situate in Cheapside on its east side acquired by the Corporation under the said Local Act for street widening purposes the following powers, namely:—

(a) to lay out and develop such lands and to erect and maintain shops, offices, warehouses and other like buildings thereon and to sell lease exchange or otherwise dispose of such buildings;

(b) to grant building leases of any such lands or other easements, rights or privileges in under or over such lands;

(c) to attach conditions or restrictions in the selling or disposing of such lands as to the use thereof and as to the buildings to be erected thereon and the use of such buildings;

(2) To enable the Corporation with the consent of the Minister of Health to exercise similar powers with respect to surplus lands acquired for street widening purposes under any Act or Order:
