sentation describing the mode in which it appears to us that the alterations above proposed may best be effected and how the changes consequent on such alterations in respect to the Ecclesiastical dues rates and payments and in respect to Patronage and rights to pews may be made with justice to all parties interested and we hereby submit the same together with the consents in writing of the said Patrons and Incumbents of the said Benefices to the intent that if Your Grace shall on full consideration and enquiry be satisfied with such Scheme you may certify the same and such consents as aforesaid to His Majesty in Council.'

And whereas the said Scheme drawn up by the said Bishop and the Consents referred to in the said Representation are as follows:—

"It is proposed to separate from the Parish of Broadwoodwidger and annex to the Parish of Ashwater all that part of the Parish of Broadwoodwidger situate north of the road from Dubb's Cross to Foxhole Cross the boundaries of which are delineated on the Ordnance Map annexed hereto and edged with red.

"That the Incumbent of the Benefice of Ashwater shall have sole and exclusive Cure of Souls within such portion so to be separated

from Broadwoodwidger.

"That any inhabitants of such portion shall be entitled to accommodation in the Parish Church of Ashwater but shall cease to be entitled to any right or accommodation in the Parish Church of Broadwoodwidger.

"That any inhabitant of the aforesaid portion shall have such and the same right to have Marriages Baptisms Churchings and Burials solemnized and performed in the Parish Church of Ashwater as they might have had in the Parish Church of Broadwoodwidger.

"That all fees, Ecclesiastical offerings and emoluments which may arise from the said portion so to be separated from Broadwoodwidger shall belong to the Incumbent of Ash-

water.

"That the whole of the Tithe Rent Charge arising out of the land proposed to be separated from Broadwoodwidger and added to the Parish of Ashwater together with all Glebe land if any in the area so to be separated is to remain the property of the Incumbent of Broadwoodwidger as heretofore.

"It is also proposed to annex the isolated portion of the Parish of Lifton situate in the Parish of Broadwoodwidger to the Parish of Broadwoodwidger the boundaries of which are delineated on the Ordnance Map annexed

hereto and edged with green.

"That the Incumbent of the Benefice of Broadwoodwidger shall have sole and exclusive Cure of Souls within such portion so to be annexed from Lifton.

"That any inhabitants of such portion shall be entitled to accommodation in the Parish Church of Broadwoodwidger but shall cease to be entitled to any right or accommodation in the Parish Church of Lifton.

"That any inhabitants of the aforesaid portion shall have such and the same right to have Marriages Baptisms Churchings and Burials solemnized and performed in the Parish

Church of Broadwoodwidger as they might have had in the Parish Church of Lifton.

"That all fees, Ecclesiastical offerings and emoluments which may arise from the said portion so to be separated from Lifton shail belong to the Incumbent of Broadwoodwidger.

"That the whole of the Tithe Rent Charge arising out of the land proposed to be separated from Lifton and added to the Parish of Broadwoodwidger together with all Glebe land if any in the area so to be separated is to remain the Property of the Incumbent of Lifton as

heretofore.

"It is also proposed to separate from the Parish of Bratton Clovelly and annex to the Parish of Broadwoodwidger all that part of the Parish of Bratton Clovelly comprising the properties known as East Banbury, West Banbury, Rexon, Staddon and Brewers the boundaries of which are delineated on the Ordnance Map annexed hereto and edged with blue.

"That the Incumbent of the Benefice of Broadwoodwidger shall have sole and exclusive Cure of Souls within such portion so to

be separated from Bratton Clovelly.

"That any inhabitants of such portion shall be entitled to accommodation in the Parish Church of Broadwoodwidger but shall cease to be entitled to any right or accommodation in the Parish Church of Bratton Clovelly.

"That any inhabitants of the aforesaid portion shall have such and the same right to have Marriages Baptisms Churchings and Burials solemnized and performed in the Parish Church of Broadwoodwidger as they might have had in the Parish Church of Bratton Clovelly.

"That all fees, Ecclesiastical offerings and emoluments which may arise from the said portion so to be separated from Bratton Clovelly shall belong to the Incumbent of Broadwood-

widger.

That the whole of the Tithe Rent Charge arising out of land proposed to be separated from Bratton Clovelly and added to the Parish of Broadwoodwidger together with all Glebe land if any in the area so to be separated is to remain the property of the Incumbent of Bratton Clovelly as heretofore.

"That no alterations shall be made in the Patronage of the said Benefices or either of

them.
