(DATED 19TH DECEMBER, 1926.)

FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE DECLARATION
OF INFECTED AREAS ORDER
OF 1926 (No. 141).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1925, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

*Declaration of Further Foot-and-Mouth
Disease Infected Area.*

1. The Area described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be a Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area for the purposes of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1925. The Foot-and-Mouth Disease Declaration of Infected Areas Order of 1926 (No. 136) shall be read and have effect as if the Area described in the Schedule hereto were included as Area No. 7 in the First Schedule to that Order.

Short Title.

2. This Order may be cited as the FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE DECLARATION OF INFECTED AREAS ORDER OF 1926 (No. 141) and shall be read with the Orders referred to in Article 1.

SCHEDULE.

Further Infected Area.

7. An Area comprising:—

In the county of Kent.

The city of Canterbury.

The boroughs of Dover, Folkestone, Margate, Ramsgate, Deal, Hythe and Sandwich.

The petty sessional divisions of Thanet, Ramsgate, Deal, Wingham, St. Augustine (except the parishes of Reculver, Herne Bay, Herne, Whitstable Urban, Swalecliffe, Whitstable cum Seasalter and St. Cosmus and St. Damian in the Blean and the detached part of the parish of Chislet), and Elham (except the detached parts of the parish of Aldington which adjoin the parish of Bonnington), the Liberties of the Cinque Ports, and the parishes of Dymchurch, Burmarsh, Eastbridge, Orgarkwick, Smeeth, Brabourne, Bircholt, Brook, Hastingleigh, and such parts of the parishes of Wye, Crundale, Godmersham and Chilham as lie to the east of the railway line running from Ashford to Ramsgate.

ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF
AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

(DATED 20TH DECEMBER, 1926.)

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1925, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

*Authorisation of Landing of Animals for
Exceptional Purposes.*

1. The landing of the animals described in the First Schedule hereto, which are intended for exceptional purposes, is hereby allowed subject to the provisions of Part II (Quarantine) of the Third Schedule to the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894, and of the Foreign Animals (Quarantine) Order of 1896, and of this Order.

Definition of Quarantine Station.

2. The premises described in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby defined as a Foreign Animals Quarantine Station for the purposes of the detention of the animals described in the First Schedule hereto.

Examination before Landing.

3. No such animals as aforesaid shall be landed except with a licence granted by an Inspector of the Ministry, which licence shall not be granted unless and until the animals have been examined by a Veterinary Inspector of the Ministry and certified by him to be free from symptoms of contagious disease.

*Regulations Applicable to the Animals on
Landing.*

4. The animals on being landed, shall forthwith be moved under the supervision of an Inspector of the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries from the quay to the premises described in the Second Schedule hereto, and shall be there detained for a period of twenty-eight days. During the said period the animals shall be kept separate from all other animals, and no other animals shall be moved into such premises.
