GAS REGULATION ACT, 1920.

IN compliance with the provisions of the Bradford Gas (Charges) Order, 1926, issued under the Gas Regulation Act, 1920, by the Board of Trade on the application of the Bradford Corporation, which Order is dated and came into operation on 29th December, 1926, notice is hereby given that the calorific value of the gas which the Corporation intend to supply is 500 British Thermal Units per cubic foot, and that the 11th day of January, 1927, is the date from which the Corporation will supply gas of the said calorific value.

COLCHESTER ELECTRICITY
(EXTENSION).
(SPECIAL ORDER.)

(The supply of Electricity by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Colchester in the urban districts of Brightlingsea, West Mersea and Wivenhoe, parts of the Rural Districts of Lexden and Winstree, Maldon and Tendring, all in the County of Essex, and part of the rural district of Samford in the County of East Suffolk.)

NOTICE is hereby given, that the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Colchester (hereinafter called "the Corporation") whose address is the Town Clerk's Office, Colchester, intend to apply to the Electricity Commissioners for a Special Order (hereinafter called "the Order") under the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1922, for all or some of the following amongst other purposes (that is to say):—

1. To extend the area of supply under the Colchester Electric Lighting Order, 1893, by adding thereto the following areas, viz.:—

(a) The Urban Districts of Brightlingsea, West Mersea, and Wivenhoe, the Rural District of Lexden and Winstree (except the detached portion of the parish of Inworth), the parishes of Tollesbury, Tolleshunt D'Arcy, Tolleshunt Knights and Tolleshunt Major in the Rural District of Maldon and the Rural District of Tendring (except the parish of Little Holland), all in the County of Essex; and

(b) the parishes of Brantham, East Bergholt and Stratford Saint Mary in the Rural District of Samford in the County of East Suffolk,

all as respectively constituted at the commencement of this Order.

The areas so proposed to be added to the said area of supply are hereinafter referred to as "the added area."

2. To authorise the Corporation to generate and supply electricity for all public and private purposes as defined by the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1922, within all portions of the added area.

3. To extend and make applicable to the added area all or some of the provisions con-

tained in the Colchester Electric Lighting Order, 1893, and to apply such provisions to the undertaking to be authorised by the Order, subject to such variations and exceptions as may be contained therein, and to repeal or amend so far as may be deemed expedient any orders made by the Board of Trade and the Electricity Commissioners under the provisions of Section 6 of the Electric Lighting Act, 1909, in relation to the supply of electricity by the Corporation to any premises within the added area.

4. To repeal, alter, extend or amend the provisions of the Colchester Electric Lighting Order, 1893, or some of those provisions, and to incorporate in the Order such of the provisions contained in the Schedule to the Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act, 1899, as are applicable and to extend some or all of such provisions to the purposes of the said Order of 1893.

5. To authorise the Corporation to open, break up, and interfere with all streets, roads, and public places, ways, footpaths, bridges, culverts, sewers, drains and gas and water mains and pipes and telegraph and telephone and other wires within the area of supply, and to lay down, erect, maintain, renew and remove either above or under ground or otherwise electric lines, conductors, mains, pipes, tubes, wires, posts, street or distributing boxes, meters, apparatus or other works or things required for the purpose of enabling the Corporation to generate, supply, store, convey, transmit or distribute electricity within the added area, and to confer all such other powers upon the Corporation as may be necessary for effecting the objects of the proposed undertaking.

6. To prescribe the maximum price or maximum prices that may be demanded and taken by the Corporation in respect of the supply of electrical energy within the added area, and to prescribe the minimum prices to be paid by persons supplied with electricity by the Corporation or connected to their electricity undertaking in that area.

7. To authorise the Corporation to fit up show-rooms, offices and installations, and to give demonstrations as to the use of electricity.

8. The names of the streets and parts of streets in the added area in which it is proposed that electric lines shall be laid down within a period to be specified by the Order are as follows:—

In the County of Essex—

Rural District of Tendring—

Parish of Lawford—

Station Road, Manningtree (from Victoria Cottages to High Street).

Parish of Manningtree—

Brook Street (from High Street to the Railway Bridge); High Street; South Street; York Street.

Parish of Mistley—

The Manningtree—Harwich main road from New Road to Shrubland Road.

Rural District of Lexden and Winstree—

Parish of Dedham—

Brook Street from the Entrance to Dedham Hall to High Street; High Street from Brook Street to its junction with the road leading to Langham.
