GAS REGULATION ACT, 1920.

Notice by the Board of Trade regarding application by the Farnham Urban District Council for an Amending Order under Sub-section (3) of Section 1 of the Gas Regulation Act, 1920, in respect of the Farnham Gas and Electricity Company.

The Board of Trade hereby give notice that the Farnham Urban District Council, having made application under Sub-section (3) of Section 1 of the above-named Act for an Amending Order revising the powers of charging authorised by the Farnham Gas (Charges) Order, 1922, the Board propose to authorise a new standard price of 13d. per therm in lieu of the existing standard price of 14.4d. per therm.
