MERCHANDISE MARKS ACT, 1926.

NOTICE TO APPLICANTS FOR ORDERS IN COUNCIL UNDER SECTION 2.

Applications for Orders in Council to require the marking of imported goods with an indication of origin under Section 2 of the Merchandise Marks Act, 1926, should be made the appropriate department, which is defined in Section 10 (1) of the Act as meaning, in relation to agricultural and horticultural produce and the produce of any fishing industry, the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, the Secretary of State for the Home Department and the Secretary of State for Scotland acting jointly, and in relation to any other goods the Board of Trade.

Accordingly applications relating to goods of all classes and descriptions other than agricultural and horticultural produce and the produce of any fishing industry should be addressed to the Secretary, Board of Trade, Great George Street, London, S.W. 1.

Applications relating to agricultural and horticultural produce and the produce of any fishing industry should be prepared in triplicate, one copy being addressed to each of the following:

- (a) The Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries, 10, Whitehall Place, London,
- (b) The Under Secretary of State, Home Office, London, S.W. 1.
- (c) The \mathbf{Under} Secretary of Scottish Office, Whitehall, London, S.W. 1.

No applications will be referred by the appropriate departments to the standing committees under the Act which will shortly be appointed, unless, in the opinion of the departments, the applications substantially represent the interests of either manufacturers, producers, dealers, traders, users or consumers, or of any body of wage-earners.
