SCHEDULE.

Contracted Infected Area.

An Area comprising:—

In the county of Essex.

The parishes of Stisted, Cressing, Faulkbourne (including its detached parts), Witham (including its detached part), Little Braxted, Great Braxted, Rivenhall, Bradwell, Pattiswick, Great Coggeshall, Markshall, Earls Colne, Little Coggeshall, Kelvedon, Feering, Messing, Inworth (including its detached part), Layer Narney, Layer Breton, Birch, Easthorpe, Marks Tey, Little Tey, Great Tey, Chappel, Aldham, Copford and Stanway; such parts of the parishes of Tolleshunt Knights and Tolleshunt D'Arcy as lie to the west and north of the road from Great Wigborough to Tolleshunt Major via Tolleshunt D'Arcy; and such parts of the parishes of Tolleshunt Major, Little Totham and Great Totham as lie to the north of the road from Tolleshunt D'Arcy to Wickham Bishops via Beckingham Hall, Long's Farm, Little Renter's Farm, Voucher's Farm, Jepcrack's Farm, Great Totham Hall and the Windmill.

STAMP DUTIES.

Whereas Section 12 (2) of the Finance Act, 1899, provides that His Majesty's Commissioners of Inland Revenue may substitute, as respects any foreign or colonial currency mentioned in the Schedule to that Act, any rate of exchange for that specified in the Schedule and may add to the Schedule a rate of exchange for any foreign or colonial currency not mentioned therein, and that such Act shall be construed as if any rate of exchange for the time being substituted or added were contained in the said Schedule, and in the case of the substitution of a rate of exchange as if the rate for which the new

rate is substituted were omitted from that Schedule; And whereas by a notice, duly advertised pursuant to the said Section in the month of July, 1926, the said Commissioners substituted certain rates of exchange for those contained in the said Schedule: Now therefore the said Commissioners do hereby give notice that they substitute the following rates of exchange for those contained in the Schedule to the Finance Act, 1899, as varied by the above mentioned notice:

Franc (French)—One hundred and twenty-five to one pound.

Franc (Belgian)—One hundred and seventy-five to one pound.

Belga—Thirty-five to one pound.

Kroner (Danish)—Eighteen to one pound.

Kroner (Norwegian)—Eighteen to one pound.

Kroner (Swedish)—Eighteen to one pound.
