

House, Nos. 1 to 8, Cotfield Street and on or towards the south-west by Water Lane.

To empower the Company to purchase and supply gas in bulk and to make further provision with respect to the cutting off of gas supplied by the Company.

To increase the capital and borrowing powers of the Company and to provide for the creation and issue by the Company of additional ordinary and redeemable and irredeemable preference and debenture stocks and mortgages and to prescribe the terms and conditions upon which such stocks and mortgages or some of them shall or may be issued.

To provide for the setting up of a scheme of co-partnership for the employees of the Company and for contributions thereto out of the funds and revenues of the Company and for the issue to the employees of stock of the Company and for the payment by the Company of superannuation and other allowances and gratuities and pensions to the employees of the Company.

To alter or amend some of the provisions of the Exeter Gas Act 1865, the Exeter Gas Act 1878 and the Exeter Gas (Charges) Order 1921 and to vary or extinguish all rights and privileges which would interfere with the objects of the Order and to confer other rights and privileges.

The Order will incorporate with or without modification all or some of the provisions of the Companies Clauses Acts 1845 and 1863, the Lands Clauses Acts, The Gasworks Clauses Acts 1847 and 1871 and any Act amending the same.

An Ordnance map on a scale of one inch to a mile showing the situation of the existing works of the Company and the boundaries of the existing and proposed extended area of supply and an Ordnance map on a scale of 25 inches to a mile showing the lands proposed to be used under the authority of the Order for gasworks, and printed copies of the draft Order have been or will be deposited for public inspection with the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Devon at his office at the Castle, Exeter, with the Clerk of the Peace for the County of the City of Exeter at his office at 10, Bedford Circus, Exeter, and at the office of the Company, 11 and 12, East Southernhay, Exeter; and printed copies of the draft Order may be obtained at the office of the Company as aforesaid and of the undermentioned Parliamentary Agents at the price of one shilling for each copy.

Any local or other public authority company or person desiring to bring before the Board of Trade any objection to the draft Order may do so by registered letter addressed to the Director of Gas Administration, Board of Trade, Great George Street, London, S.W. 1, and dispatched on or before the 3rd day of March 1927. Any objection must state (a) the specific grounds of objections and (b) the omissions additions or modifications asked for and a copy thereof must at the same time be forwarded to the undermentioned Parliamentary Agents.
