ELECTRICITY (SUPPLY) ACTS,
1882 to 1926.SCARBOROUGH ELECTRICITY SPECIAL
ORDER, 1927.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Electricity Commissioners have submitted to the Minister of Transport for confirmation under the above-mentioned Acts a Special Order made by them for the supply by the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the borough of Scarborough of electricity within the borough of Scarborough, the urban district of Scalby and the rural district of Scarborough in the North Riding of the county of York and the urban district of Filey in the East Riding of the county of York.
