#### ELECTRICITY (SUPPLY) ACTS, 1882 TO 1926.

##### BRIDGEND ELECTRICITY (EXTENSION) SPECIAL ORDER, 1927.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Electricity Commissioners have submitted to the Minister of Transport for confirmation under the above-mentioned Acts a Special Order made by them for the supply by the Urban District Council of Bridgend of electricity within part of the Rural District of Penybont in the County of Glamorgan.
