

## URBAN DISTRICT OF PENISTONE.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACT, 1925.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AMENDMENT ACT, 1907.

**BY** an Order taking effect on the sixth day of June, 1927, the Minister of Health has:—

(1) Consented to the adoption by the Urban District Council of Penistone of section 21 (prevention of water flowing on footpath), and the sections contained in Part V (water courses), of the Public Health Act, 1925, subject as regards sections 51, 52, 53 and 54 to the conditions mentioned in the Second Schedule to the Order, and

(2) Has declared the provisions of section 25 (paving of yards in connection with dwelling-houses) and Part III (sanitary provisions) of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907, subject as regards sections 35 and 38 to the conditions mentioned in the First Schedule to the Order to be in force in the Urban District of Penistone.

ELECTRICITY (SUPPLY) ACTS,  
1882 TO 1926.SOUTHWOLD AND DISTRICT ELECTRICITY  
SPECIAL ORDER, 1927.

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Electricity Commissioners have submitted to the Minister of Transport for confirmation under the above-mentioned Acts a Special Order made by them, for the supply by the Southwold Electricity Supply Company, Limited, of electricity within the Borough of Southwold and the Parishes of Reydon and Walberswick in the Rural District of Blything in the Administrative County of East Suffolk.

The Minister of Transport proposes to confirm the Order and gives notice that any person affected who may be desirous of objecting to the confirmation of the same must in accordance with the Electricity (Confirmation of Special Orders) Rules, 1921, do so by memorial addressed to the Minister of Transport written on one side only of foolscap paper and sent by registered post addressed to the Secretary, Ministry of Transport, 6, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W. 1, and posted not later than the 3rd day of August, 1927. A copy of any such memorial must also be sent in like manner to Messrs. Godfrey Warr Clarkson & Company, 85, Gracechurch Street, London, E.C. 3, Solicitors for the Order. Such memorial must be sealed or signed by the person objecting or by some responsible and duly authorised person on his behalf and must state the specific grounds of objection to the Order and the modifications desired.

## NORWICH ELECTRICITY (EXTENSION).

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Mayor Aldermen and Citizens of the City of Norwich (hereinafter referred to as "the Undertakers") whose address is the Guildhall, Norwich, have applied to the Electricity Commissioners for a Special Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") under the Electricity (Supply) Acts 1882 to 1926, for all or some of the following purposes (that is to say):—

1. To extend the area of supply of the Undertakers so as to authorise them to supply electricity for all public and private purposes as defined by the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1926 within the following areas (hereinafter referred to as "the added area") that is to say:—
