

2. If any animal or thing is moved, or if any person does, or omits to do, anything in contravention of this Order or of the conditions contained in any licence granted hereunder, the owner of the animal or thing and the person for the time being in charge thereof, and the person doing the same or failing to do anything which by the conditions of the licence he is required to do, as the case may be, shall each according to and in respect of his own acts or defaults be deemed guilty of an offence against the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894.

3. This Order shall be executed and enforced except where otherwise provided by the Local Authority.

FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED  
AREAS) ORDER OF 1927 (No. 26).

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1925, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

*Contraction of Certain Infected Area.*

1. The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas) Order of 1927 (No. 25) shall be read and have effect as if the Area described in the Schedule to this Order were substituted for the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area described in the Schedule to that Order.

*Revocation of Certain Order.*

2. The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Birmingham Pig Market) Order of 1927 is hereby revoked.

*Commencement.*

3. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-fifth day of July, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven.

*Short Title.*

4. This Order may be cited as the FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1927 (No. 26).

1. The Area described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be a Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area for the purposes of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1925.

*Short Title.*
