THE ROADS ACT, 1920.

COUNTY OF WORCESTER.

Notice is hereby given that on the twenty-fifth day of August, 1927, the Minister of Transport made an Order under Section 7 (4) of the Roads Act, 1920, in respect of certain highways in the County of Worcester.

The Order will come into force on the third day of September, 1927, and is to the following effect:—

From the date on which the Order comes into force, no person shall drive or cause to be driven on the highway specified in
