**UNIVERSITY OF OXFORD.**

**STATUTE APPROVED BY CONGREGATION ON  
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 29, 1927.**

*WHEREAS it is expedient to amend Section I. § 1. cl. 10 of Titulus VII of the Statutes of the University of Oxford so as to remove an inconsistency: NOW THE SAID UNIVERSITY in exercise of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923, and of all other powers enabling it, ENACTS, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF HIS MAJESTY IN COUNCIL, AS FOLLOWS.*

In Statt. Tit. VII. Sect. I. § 1. cl. 10, the words " and of his having passed the Examinations required for the Degree of Bachelor of Arts " shall be struck out.
