## WIDOWS' ORPHANS' AND OLD AGE CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS ACT, 1925.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee and the Minister of Health, acting jointly, after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (1) of Section 10 of the Widows' Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act, 1925, to make Regulations with respect to the payment of contributions payable under that Act for persons over 65 years of age;

And that on account of urgency the National Health Insurance Joint Committee and the Minister of Health, acting jointly, have, under Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made regulations, entitled the Contributory Pensions (Collection of Contributions for Persons over 65) Regulations, 1927, to come into force immediately as provisional regulations, to continue in force until regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of Section 1 of that Act;

## SPALDING.

Whereas the Urban District Council of Spalding (hereinafter called the Council), have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order under Sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act, 1875, partially to repeal, alter or amend the Spalding Improvement Act, 1853, so as:—
