#### WIDOWS' ORPHANS' AND OLD AGE CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS ACT, 1925.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee and the Minister of Health, acting jointly and in conjunction with the Treasury, after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sub-sections (2) and (4) of Section 13 of the Widows' Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act, 1925, to make Regulations for amending the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (Voluntary Contributors) Regulations, 1925;

And that on account of urgency the National Health Insurance Joint Committee under Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made regulations entitled the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (Voluntary Contributors) Amendment Regulations, 1927, to come into force immediately as provisional regulations to continue in force until regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of Section 1 of that Act;
