LOUTH ELECTRICITY (SPECIAL ORDER).

NOTICE is hereby given that the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Louth (hereinafter called "the Corporation") whose address is Town Hall, Louth, in the Parts of Lindsey and County of Lincoln have applied to the Electricity Commissioners under the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1926, for a Special Order (hereinafter called "the Order") for all or some of the following objects (that is to say):—

To authorise the Corporation to supply and distribute electrical energy for all public and private purposes as defined by the said Acts within the Borough of Louth in the Parts of Lindsey and County of Lincoln (hereinafter called "the area of supply").

To authorise the Corporation to exercise within the area of supply the powers usually conferred on distributors of electricity.

To prescribe and limit the price to be charged by the Corporation for the supply of electricity.

To authorise the Corporation in connection with their electricity undertaking to fit up showrooms and offices and exhibit specimen installations and give demonstrations of the uses to which electrical energy can be put.

The names of the streets in which it is proposed that electric lines shall be laid down

within a period to be specified by the Order are as follows:—

In the Borough of Louth:—

Corn Market
Market Place.
Mercer Row.

To authorise the Corporation to break up in the area of supply the following streets not repairable by the local authority and railways:—

Mount Olivet, High Holme-Mill Lane, Leake's Row, Malt House Lane, Station Hill, River Head Wharf, Alexandra Road, Ramsgate Crescent, Little George Street, Little South Street, Cinder Lane, South Terrace, Watt's Lane, Julian Bower, Hawthorne Avenue.

Railways:—

In the Borough of Louth:—

The level crossings of the London and North Eastern Railway—

- (1) At Keddington Road (known as the Keddington Road Crossing);
- (2) At Monks Dyke Road (known as the Monks Dyke Crossing).

Every local or other public authority company or person being desirous of bringing before the Electricity Commissioners any objection respecting the application may do so by registered letter addressed to the Secretary, Electricity Commission, Savoy Court, Strand, London, W.C.2, and despatched on or before the 27th February, 1928, and a copy of such objection must also be forwarded to the under-mentioned Town Clerk or Parliamentary Agents.
