

BARRY.

Whereas the Urban District Council of Barry have made application to the Minister of Health for the issue of a Provisional Order under Sections 297 and 303 of the Public Health Act, 1875, partially to repeal, alter or amend the Barry Urban District Council Act, 1913, so as:—

(1) To increase by not exceeding 100 per cent.:—

(a) The rates prescribed by section 17 of the said Local Act for supply of water for domestic purposes;

(b) The charge prescribed by section 18 of the said Local Act for water supplied to stables or premises for horses or for washing carriages or motor cars where a hose pipe or similar apparatus is used;

(c) The maximum price prescribed by section 25 of the said Local Act for a supply of water by measure and the minimum sum in respect of such supply in any quarter of a year;

(2) To empower the Minister of Health from time to time by order further to alter, increase or modify the rates charges and maximum price for supplies of water;

(3) For the several purposes of the Application or for purposes connected with, incidental to, or consequent on those purposes to make any such alteration or amendment of the said Local Act, or of any other Local Act or of any Act confirming a Provisional Order made in pursuance of any of the Sanitary Acts or of the Public Health Act, 1875, and in force in the said District as may be necessary or desirable:

And whereas it is proposed that a Provisional Order should be issued in compliance with the said Application;

Notice is hereby given that A. E. H. Goddard, Esq., one of the Inspectors of the Ministry of Health will attend at the Council Chambers, Barry, on Thursday, the twenty-third day of February, 1928, at eleven o'clock in the forenoon, to hold a Local Inquiry into the subject-matter of the said Application and the proposed Provisional Order.

And notice is hereby further given that any person interested may attend at such Inquiry and be heard with reference to the said Application and the proposed Provisional Order.

IN THE MATTER OF THE LONDON TRAFFIC ACT, 1924.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Minister of Transport after the expiration of at least forty days from this date in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by Section 7 of the aforesaid London Traffic Act to make regulations amending the London Traffic (Restricted Streets) Regulations.

And notice is hereby further given that on account of urgency the Minister of Transport has under Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made the London Traffic (Restricted Streets) Amendment (Routes Nos. 8a and 160) Provisional Regulations, 1928, to come into operation forthwith as provisional regulations to continue in force until regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of Section 1 of that Act.

These Regulations empower the Tramways (M.E.T.) Omnibus Company Limited to operate certain omnibus journeys, over restricted streets, formerly operated by the London General Omnibus Company Limited.
