

tance of 14½ chains or thereabouts to its junction with the road called Ashurst Drive, and extending thence south westward along the middle of Ashurst Drive for a distance of 2½ chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said New Parish of the Trinity, Barkingside, from the said Parish of Great Ilford.

" II. And also all that contiguous portion of the said Parish of Great Ilford which is bounded upon the north east, upon the north west and upon the west by the above described portion of the said New Parish of the Trinity, Barkingside, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the south and upon the south east, by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of the Trinity, Barkingside, from the said Parish of Great Ilford at a point in the middle of Cranbrook Road opposite to the wall or fence forming the boundary which divides the Ilford County High School for Girls from the houses and premises situate on the southern side of the road called Bramley Crescent, and extending thence first eastward to and then first eastward, then south eastward and then north eastward along the said wall or fence forming the southern boundary of the said houses and premises situate on the southern side of Bramley Crescent for a distance of 13 chains or thereabouts to the point where such wall or fence meets the south western side of Perth Road, and extending thence first north eastward to and then south eastward along the middle of Perth Road for a distance of 8 chains or thereabouts to its junction with the road called South View Crescent, and extending thence north eastward along the middle of South View Crescent for a distance of 9½ chains or thereabouts to its junction with the road called Eastern Avenue, and extending thence south eastward along the middle of Eastern Avenue for a distance of 9½ chains or thereabouts to its junction with Ashurst Drive, and extending thence north eastward along the middle of Ashurst Drive for a distance of 14 chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said Parish of Great Ilford from the said New Parish of the Trinity, Barkingside."

And whereas drafts of the said Scheme have, in accordance with the provisions of the secondly hereinbefore mentioned Act, been transmitted to the Patrons and to the Incumbents of the Cures out of which it is intended that the District recommended in such Scheme to be constituted shall be taken, and such Patrons and Incumbents have respectively signified their assent to such Scheme:

And whereas the said Scheme has been approved by His Majesty in Council:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His said Council, is pleased hereby to ratify the said Scheme, and to order and direct that the same and every part thereof shall be effectual in law immediately from and after the time when this Order shall have been duly published in the London Gazette pursuant to the said Acts.

And His Majesty, by and with the like advice, is pleased hereby to direct that this Order be forthwith registered by the Registrar of the said Diocese of Chelmsford.

WHEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have, in pursuance of the Act of the 6th and 7th years of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, Chapter 77, of the Act of the 3rd and 4th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 113, and of the Act of the 37th and 38th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 63, duly prepared, and laid before His Majesty in Council, a Scheme, bearing date the 15th day of March, 1928, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

" We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the 6th and 7th years of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, Chapter 77, of the Act of the 3rd and 4th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 113, and of the Act of the 37th and 38th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 63, have prepared, and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council, the following Scheme with respect to the Archdeaconries of Cleveland and York (or the West Riding), in the Diocese of York, and to some of the Rural Deaneries within such Archdeaconries:

" Whereas it has been represented to us by the Right Honourable and Most Reverend Cosmo Gordon, Archbishop of York, that the arrangements which are hereinafter recommended and proposed with respect to the said Archdeaconries of Cleveland and York (or the West Riding) and with respect to some of the Rural Deaneries within such Archdeaconries are desirable and should be carried into effect and we are of opinion that the same may be properly carried into effect:

" Now, therefore, with the consent of the said Cosmo Gordon, Archbishop of York (in testimony whereof he has set his hand and Archiepiscopal Seal to this Scheme), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly recommend and propose that as from the day on which any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme shall be published in the London Gazette and without any assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order, first, the name of the said Archdeaconry of York (or the West Riding) shall be altered so that such Archdeaconry shall henceforth be called ' The Archdeaconry of York ' ; secondly, a new rural Deanery shall be formed within the said Archdeaconry of Cleveland and such new Rural Deanery shall be called ' The Rural Deanery of Pickering ' ; and thirdly, the said Rural Deanery of Pickering and the Rural Deaneries of Helmsley and Malton, in the said Archdeaconry of Cleveland, and the Rural Deaneries of Bulmer, Easingwold, and the City of York, in the said Archdeaconry of York, shall respectively comprise and consist of the Parishes, Cures and Churches, the names of which are set down in numbered order under the names of such Rural Deaneries respectively in the first column of the Schedule to this Scheme annexed, and each of the said Parishes or Cures or Churches shall belong to and be and
