In Four Portions.—
contd.

Third Portion.—At Bedford Avenue, eight carriages on the South side of the roadway, commencing at a point three yards East of the Eastern building line of Tottenham Court Road, and extending Eastward, by kerb, as far as necessary for eight carriages.

Front of vehicles toward the West.

NOTE.—Between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7.30 p.m. four carriages only will be permitted to stand on this portion of the rank, the commencing point for which portion will then be by the lamp-post on the South side of the roadway approximately nineteen yards East of the Eastern building line of Tottenham Court Road.

Front of vehicles toward the West.

Fourth Portion.—At Bedford Avenue, twenty-one carriages on the North side of roadway, commencing at a point three yards East of the Eastern building line of Caroline Street and extending Eastward, by kerb, as far as necessary for twenty-one carriages.

Front of vehicles toward the West.

The first portion of the Standing to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion, the second portion by carriages from the third portion and the third portion by carriages from the fourth portion.

Provided that no Hackney Carriage shall be suffered to stand across any street or thoroughfare, or opposite the end of any street or carriageway, or upon any place where foot passengers usually cross the carriageway.
