

Trade Board's Notice R.B. (C.M.) 2 shall be the Minimum Rates specified in such notice R.B. (C.M.) 2, and *applicable in Area D*, instead of, as at present, the Minimum Rates applicable in Area C;

(3) that the Minimum Rates applicable to Workers employed in the Area comprising the Urban District of Rushden of the several classes specified in the Trade Board's Notice R.B. (C.M.) 2 shall be the Minimum Rates specified in such Notice R.B. (C.M.) 2 and *applicable in Area C*, as proposed to be varied under the terms of Paragraph (1) above, instead of, as at present, the Minimum Rates applicable in Area D.

Pursuant to Section 3 (5) of the Trade Boards Act, 1918, the Trade Board will consider any Objections to the above Proposal which may be lodged with them within two months from the 22nd day of May, 1928. Such Objections should be in writing and signed by the person making the same (adding his or her full name and address), and should be sent to the Secretary, Retail Bespoke Tailoring Trade Board (England and Wales), 1, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W. 1.

It is desirable that the Objections should state precisely, and so far as possible with reasons, what is objected to.
